














Stop your constant expansion. Stop insisting on your growth economy, on acquiring more and more until you consume the entire planet.






Stop putting

into our water


Stop allowing motor oil to be put in our water. Stop flushing your drugs and cleaning chemicals into our water.


It's not that simple
